

Biographies of Sonya Dodginghorse & Cayda Dodginghorse

Sonya Taypotat-Dodginghorse is the youngest child of Louis & Bernice Taypotat of Kahkewistahaw First Nation. Louis along with his sons, daughters, and grandchildren have competed in the amateur, semi-pro and pro rodeo circuits throughout Canada and the United States. Sonya has made her home on the Tsuut'ina Nation for the last 12 years married to her best friend and biggest support Brent Dodginghorse who is also an Indian World Champion in the Steer Wrestling event and an alumnus of the WHL hockey team Calgary Hitmen. They reside on their ranch with their daughter Cayda, and their fur babies Olive and Lucy.

Sonya is an educator and advocator for educating people of the effects from historical trauma from Indian Residential Schools. She is a role model for indigenous women and youth sharing her knowledge and experiences. She also volunteers in the community hosting youth rodeo events. While Sonya and her family have experienced hardships and overcoming trauma from her own illness, to losing her niece to Lupus, to her brother and dad being diagnosed with Cancer, and to her husband being diagnosed with MS, Sonya remains a true champion for bringing public awareness to those causes through helping family and friends with events.

Sonya is also a champion for God and glorifying Him for her faith, belief, resilience and success she has achieved. She is truly a humble woman warrior inspiring her daughter and others to learn, work hard and succeed. As a champion barrel racer, she also loves, respects and honours her horses by investing many hours and expense of caring for their health and conditioning while finding that balance with her own mental, spiritual and physical health and well-being.

Despite the Covid-19 pandemic, Sonya aspires to continue competing in the pro rodeo circuits to qualify for the 2022 Canadian Finals Rodeo (CFR) in Red Deer, Alberta, bring home another World Title at the 2022 INFR.

Cayda is Sonya's next generation and is following in her mother's footsteps. Cayda has had to learn to balance her busy schedule between her academics as a grade 10 student, rodeo, hockey, volleyball and caring for her horse along with her own physical, mental and spiritual well-being. Albeit her hectic schedule she maintains her academic grades. Cayda, like her mom, puts in countless hours to achieve her goals and aspirations.

Cayda, at 15 years old, is a determined young rodeo athlete. She competed in the Junior barrels and Ladies barrels at the 2019 INFR. She was crowned with the Junior Barrel Racing Indian world title and placed 5th in the average in the Ladies. Cayda aspires to continue to compete in the Junior division with setting her goal on qualifying for the 2022 INFR and bringing home another Indian world title. Just like her mom, she will compete in the pro rodeo circuits to aspire to qualify for the 2022 Canadian Finals Rodeo (CFR) in Red Deer, Alberta.

Sonya and Cayda have made INFR history twofold as they both were crowned Indian World Champions in their respective events as a mother and daughter duo, and it was the first time that both Junior and Ladies Barrel Racing championships were won by Canadians. A blessing and an achievement that they along with their family and friends are very thankful and proud of.


