- Tent, sleeping bag, pillow, ground pad
- Flashlight or headlamp
- Refillable water bottle
- Clothing for all weather, including warm layers & rain gear
- Closed-toed shoes or boots (mandatory for horse areas)
- · Jeans or leggings for riding activities
- Toiletries & towel
- Bug spray and sunscreen

Note: Snacks and beverages will be provided and safely stored in the barn.

🚨 Safety & Participant Criteria

All groups must <u>bring their own chaperones</u>, please ensure a 1:4 safety ratio. Additional DH Ranch support is in place during horse-related activities to ensure safety.

- Youth must be 18 or under
- Must follow all safety protocols
- No open-toed shoes allowed around horses
- No alcohol, drugs, or vaping
- Campfires are supervised at all times
- Medications must be labeled and handed to staff
